APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO PREPARE RECORD AND INDEX

Appellant pro se Neil J. Gillespie hereby files this Motion for and Extension of Time to Prepare the Record and Index and in support thereof states:

- 1. The Clerk of the Court of the lower tribunal is cooperating with Appellant to prepare the Record and Index based upon the authority of G. Wv. Karen Rushing, Clerk of Circuit Court, 22 So.3d 819 (Fla. 2d DCA 2009). (Exhibit A). Appellant received the Index to the Record from the Clerk January 27, 2011. Appellant notified the Clerk's Counsel Dale Bohner of errors, omissions and duplications, etc. in the Record and Index by fax January 31, 2011. (Exhibit B).
- 2. Mr. Mark Ware, Esq., Hillsborough County Office of the Clerk of Court, Lisa Mann, Associate Director of Appeals Department, and Appellant had a teleconference February 2, 2011 to discuss and resolve errors, omissions, duplications and other issues with the Record and Index to the Record. Mr. Ware said he was referred to Appellant by the Clerk's Counsel Dale Bohner for this purpose.

- 3. Attached is Appellant's email to Mr. Ware February 3, 2011 setting forth the issues to resolve with the Record and Index and proposed remedies. (Exhibit C).
- 4. Attached is Appellant's fax letter to The Honorable James M. Barton, II, requesting His Honor file with the Clerk of the Court communication between His Honor, Neil J. Gillespie, Ryan C. Rodems and Barker, Rodems & Cook, PA. (Exhibit D). As shown in Exhibit D, the emails with Count Counsel David Rowland, Mr. Rowland is not cooperating with Appellant and matters pertaining to the record. Appellant is hopeful that Judge Barton will voluntarily file with the Clerk the requested communication and has requested a response by February 10, 2011.
- 5. The Record has not yet been transmitted. Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P., Rule 9.200(f)(1) if there is an error or omission in the record the lower tribunal may correct the record before the record is transmitted. That effort is currently underway.
- 6. Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P., Rule 9.200(e) the burden to ensure that the record is prepared and transmitted in accordance with these rules shall be on the appellant.

 Therefore Appellant moves for an extension of time of 30 days to ensure that the record is prepared and transmitted in accordance with these rules.
- 7. On January 7, 2011 this Court granted Appellant a 30 day extension to file the Initial Brief. Appellant is unable to timely serve the brief due to the aforementioned issues with the Record and Index. This Court's Order stated that "If the appellant is unable to timely serve the brief due to the delay of this third party, the next appropriate step is the filing of a motion to compel in this court." Appellant believes that the issues with the Record and Index will be resolved by the Clerk without court order within 30 days and has requested a 30 day extension in the preceding paragraph. However it is

unknown at this time if The Honorable James M. Barton, II, will file with the Clerk communication between His Honor, Neil J. Gillespie, Ryan C. Rodems and Barker, Rodems & Cook, PA. (Exhibit D).

8. Pursuant to Fla. R. App. P., Rule 9.300(b) service of a motion shall toll the time schedule of any proceeding in the court until disposition of the motion. An order granting an extension of time for any act shall automatically extend the time for all other acts that bear a time relation to it. An order granting an extension of time for preparation of the record, or the index to the record, or for filing of the transcript of proceedings, shall extend automatically, for a like period, the time for service of appellant's initial brief.

Therefore Appellant requests that time be tolled for the filing of his Initial Brief.

9. Appellant did not contact opposing counsel Ryan Christopher Rodems due to past problems and believe he may object to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Appellant pro se, NEIL J. GILLESPIE, respectfully requests this Court grant this Motion for Extension of Time for 30 days and other relief as this Court deems necessary under the circumstances.

Dear Mr. Ware:

It was a pleasure speaking with you and Lisa Mann Wednesday Feb-02-11. I appreciate the assistance you and Ms. Mann provided. Thank you for the information about indigent status, the Clerk's invoice to me for costs of \$585.77, and sections 57.081 and 57.082, Florida Statutes. I forgot to ask, how was the \$585.77 in costs calculated? I will review the statutes you referenced within the next few days or so.

Later today I will file a motion in 2D10-5197 for an extension of time to complete the Record and the Index to the Record. Please advise if you would like a copy of the motion.

During our teleconference we determined the following regarding the Record and the Index to the Record:

Corrections needed:

- 1. The trial transcript appears missing but is actually a mislabeled duplicate of a transcript of July 12, 2010 before Judge Martha Cook, index T1-T26 and index 2952-2967. The date of the trial (Final Summary Judgment, Count 1) is September 28, 2010.
- 2. Transcript of hearing October 1, 2009 before Judge James M. Barton, II appears twice, once at index 1610-1622 and again at index 1649-1661. Lisa Mann will remove one.
- 3. June 14, 2010, P's motion disqualify Judge Cook appears twice, once at index 2432-2466 and again at index 2470-2504. Lisa Mann will remove one.
- 4. Lisa Mann noted various typos, date errors, and chronological order changes needed. I noted dates of some documents were missing. Lisa Mann will make needed corrections.
