
Dear Mr. Cervone:

On April 12, 2011 I made a request for prosecution of Robert W. Bauer under chapter 825, Florida Statutes, Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation of Elderly Persons and Disabled Adults, to Mr. Brian Kramer, Assistant State Attorney, in the Gainesville office. Postal records show the request was received by Mr. Kramer ten (10) days ago, April 13, 2011.

As of today I have not received a response from Mr. Kramer or your office. When can I expect to receive a response to my request for prosecution of Mr. Bauer? Kindly describe the process and procedure for the Office of the State Attorney, Eighth Judicial Circuit, in a case like this.

When the State Attorney fails to respond to a complainant, it is a violation of the public trust, reflects discredit upon the official and their agency, suggests partiality in the consideration of complaints, and undermines confidence in government. Thank you.
