Previously you represented Sarah May Thompson, DOB June 9, 1985, an unremarried widow, in Marion County Criminal Case 42-2014-CF-002361-AXXX-XX.
Count I: Evidence Tampering; Alprazolam pill
Count II: Retail Petit Theft; Fishing reel, coffee, or a recorder
Count III: Resist Law Enforcement Officer Without Violence

Last week Ms. Thompson moved into my home as a live-in home health provider, see attached. On June 16, 2019 Sarah admitted to taking prescription medication from my room. Sarah apologized and promised not to take my pills again.

I don't know what to do. I have no faith in the Marion County Sheriff's Office, over issues related to my home foreclosure (2013-CA-00115). I have no faith in the UDEST or DCF. I do not want to report Sarah to L.E. (I support legalizing drugs). But I may not be the best person to help Sarah. I am aware she placed a newborn for adoption in 2015. She arrived at my door the result of mistaken identity through a website. Initially Sarah seemed nice, and she needed a place to stay. I felt compassion for a homeless, unremarried widow. And it is difficult for a single man age 63 with health issues and limited income to find competent help. Previously two other providers did not work out, one age 40 (drugs) and one age 43 (drinking/smoking).

Currently Sarah has a broken tooth that needs extraction, but she refuses medical treatment I found, see <https://www.truecaredentistocala.com/emergency-dentist.html>

I don't want to throw Sarah out into the street. I believe she needs stability, but the people in her life may not be stable. I would appreciate any suggestions you may have. Thank you.

Plan (in part) "Counseled the patient about the independent living facility but the patient suddenly was upset and said he will terminate the visit and left the office."

Gillespie's unilateral Plan B: In lieu of the independent living facility, I changed doctors, and want to have a live-in home health provider / personal assistant.

Position: Home health provider

Live-in position includes a private bedroom, private toilet, shared shower, use of a red lap-top HP computer and WI-FI service. All utilities are included. Use of a washer/dryer, use of the common areas of the home, and use of the amenities at Oak Run are included. Gillespie will provide dish washing soap, laundry detergent, bleach, fabric softener, and dryer sheets.

Provider duties include meal planning, shopping, meal preparation, housekeeping, and exercise/walking partner, in lieu of any form of payment.

- Meal planning means making a monthly menu plan of meals served twice a day (lunch and dinner, about 60 meals a month), within a monthly budget.
- Shopping means obtaining food and other items for the monthly menu plan of meals.
- Meal preparation means preparing, serving, and clean-up for the monthly menu plan.
- Housekeeping means cleaning the shared walk-in shower, cleaning the kitchen, cleaning the common areas of the home, cleaning provider's room, sweeping the patio, and pulling weeds.

Provider will share the expense for food. Provider must provide her own personal hygiene products, shampoo, conditioner, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste.

The Provider is an independent contractor without any benefits not expressly stated. The provider is free to engage in other work or activity that is separate and independent from the live-in position. The Provider assumes any and all risks associated with other work or activity. The provider must have a current Florida driver's license because this is a rural area without adequate public transportation. The provider must be a non-smoker due to Gillespie's health. Provider must not take items or medication not belonging to them, unless granted permission.

Conditional provider: Sarah May Thompson, an unremarried widow.

ON 06/24/2019, WRITER RESPONDED 8092 SW 115TH LOOP, IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT.

WRITER MADE CONTACT WITH THE REPORTEE NEIL GILLESPIE, WHO ADVISED HIS CAMERA IS MISSING. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THE CAMERA IS A CANON POWER SHOT A710 IS VALUED AT \$30.00 WITH A POSSIBLE SERIAL NUMBER OF (21)3128215178. THE REPORTEE ADVISED HE IS UNSURE IF THE CAMERA WAS STOLEN OR IS JUST MISSING INSIDE THE RESIDENCE. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THE LAST TIME HE OBSERVED THE CAMERA, IT WAS ON A SHELF IN THE HALL WAY AREA OF THE RESIDENCE ON WEDNESDAY 06/19/2019 AFTER A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT HAD OCCURRED WITH HIS ROOM MATE. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THE SUBJECT SARAH THOMPSON, HAD SEEN AN IMAGINARY PERSON INSIDE THE RESIDENCE ON WEDNESDAY AND HE TOLD HER TO TAKE A PICTURE OF THE PERSON WITH THE CAMERA. THE REPORTEE ADVISED HE REALIZED THE CAMERA WAS MISSING SATURDAY 06/22/2019. THE REPORTEE ADVISED HE DOESN'T WISH TO PRESS ANY CHARGES AT THIS TIME DUE TO THE CAMERA POSSIBLY BEING LOST.

WRITER MADE CONTACT SUBJECT SARAH THOMPSON, WHO ADVISED SHE MOVED INTO THE RESIDENCE LAST FRIDAY 06/14/2019, DUE TO HER BEING HOMELESS AND NOT HAVING ANYWHERE ELSE TO GO. THE SUBJECT ADVISED SHE FOUND THE REPORTEE ON CRAIGSLIST AND HE ALLOWED HER TO MOVE INTO THE RESIDENCE TO HELP HER OUT. THE SUBJECT ADVISED THERE WAS NO INCIDENT WITH HER SEEING IMAGINARY PEOPLE INSIDE THE RESIDENCE. THE SUBJECT ADVISED SHE HAS NOT SEEN THE SUBJECT'S CAMERA AND SHE DOES NOT KNOW WHAT HAPPENED TO IT. THE SUBJECT ADVISED THE REPORTEE IS "CRAZY" AND SHE IS LEAVING THE RESIDENCE TODAY DUE TO THE REPORTEE ASKING HER TO MARRY HIM THE DAY AFTER SHE MOVED IN.

ON 07/08/2019 WRITER AND DETECTIVE TUCKER, ID 1344, CONDUCTED A PAWN SEARCH FOR THE MISSING CAMERA FROM 05/01/2019 TO 07/08/2019 BY JUST THE SERIAL NUMBER, JUST THE MODEL NUMBER, AND SERIAL AND MODEL NUMBER TOGETHER. THERE HAS BEEN NO PAWN ACTIVITY WITH THE ITEM'S DESCRIPTION. A PAWN SEARCH WAS ALSO CONDUCTED ON THE SUBJECT SARAH THOMPSON'S NAME AND THE SEARCH CAME BACK NEGATIVE FOR ANY PAWN ACTIVITY.

ON 07/06/2019 WRITER RECEIVED AN EMAIL FROM THE REPORTEE, NEIL GILLESPIE, ADVISED HE HAD MORE INFORMATION REGARDING THIS CASE. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE HAD CONDUCTED AN ONLINE COMPUTER SEARCH OF THE MISSING ITEM AND DETERMINED HIS VALUATION WAS LOW. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE ALSO HAD AN UPGRADED MEMORY CARD THAT WAS WITH THE CAMERA AT THE TIME OF THIS INCIDENT. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE WOULD VALUE BOTH THE CAMERA AND CARD AT \$75. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE RECALLED A VISITOR TO HIS HOME AROUND THE TIME THE CAMERA WENT MISSING, A FRIEND OF SARAH THOMPSON, WHO HAD OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE THE CAMERA. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT THE VISITOR WAS A WHITE FEMALE IN HER 30'S CALLED FRANKIE, WHO STOPPED BY TO FIX THE LATCH ON THE SLIDING GLASS DOORS TO SUBJECT'S ROOM. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT FRANKIE LIVES IN THE VILLAGES WITH HER MOTHER AND WAS DRIVING A LATE MODEL WHITE COLOR BUICK, POSSIBLY AN ENCORE MODEL.

ON WEDNESDAY 061919, WRITER RECEIVED WHAT IS BELIEVED TO BE A FORWARDED EMAIL FROM THE REPORTEE TO ASSISTANT PUBLIC DEFENDER SUSAN BAILEY. THE EMAIL STATES THAT MRS. BAILEY PREVIOUSLY REPRESENTED THE SUBJECT IN THIS CASE FOR OTHER THEFT CHARGES. THE REPORTEE ADVISED IN THE EMAIL THAT HE HAD NO FAITH IN THE MARION COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE DUE TO A PREVIOUS INCIDENT REGARDING A FORECLOSURE ON HIS RESIDENCE. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE DOES NOT WANT TO REPORT THE SUBJECT IN THIS CASE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT. THE REPORTEE ALSO MENTIONED THAT THE SUBJECT HAS A BROKEN TOOTH THAT NEEDS MEDICAL TREATMENT. THE REPORTEE ADVISES IN THE EMAIL THAT HE IS LOOKING FOR SUGGESTIONS TO HELP THE SUBJECT OUT.

ON 071519, THE REPORTEE EMAILED WRITER ADVISING THAT THE SUBJECT HAD TAKEN MORE ITEMS ON OR AROUND 071419. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT THE SUBJECT TOOK APPROXIMATELY \$94.27 WORTH OF MISCELLANEOUS HOUSEHOLD ITEMS FROM HER FURNISHED BEDROOM. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE IS MISSING A HOUSE KEY, GATE KEY, ROOM KEY, LOWEPRO, CAMERA SHOULDER BAG, A WASTE BAND, TOOTH BRUSH HOLDER, A SMALL BROWN WASTE PAPER CONTAINER, A LARGE PLASTIC UNDER THE BED CLOTHING STORAGE BEN, A RED POLKA DOT STORAGE BEN, A PURPLE STORAGE BEN, AND AN AQUA AND WHITE STORAGE BEN. THE REPORTEE ADVISES THAT HE BELIEVES THAT IT WILL COST \$65.00 TO \$95.00 TO GET THE COMPUTER UNLOCKED BY A PROFESSIONAL. THE REPORTEE ALSO ADVISES THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO MEET AT THE SOUTH WEST DISTRICT OFFICE WITH THE SUBJECT TO EXCHANGE BELONGINGS.

ON 071619, THE REPORTEE HAD EMAILED WRITER ADVISING THAT HE NEEDED TO AMEND THE NEW LIST OF ITEMS MISSING. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT THE SUBJECT ALSO TOOK A ZR900 CANNON DIGITAL VIDEO CAMCORDER, VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$25.00 TO \$35.00. THE REPORTEE ADVISED POSSIBLE SERIAL NUMBER OF 2487B001 (AA). THE REPORTEE ADVISED HE IS ALSO MISSING A WHITE SAMSUNG HMX-F90 HD CAMCORDER, VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$75.00. THE REPORTEE IS ALSO MISSING BETTER HOLMES AND GARDENS BRONZE RISEN OWL NIGHT LAMP, VALUED AT \$25.00. THE REPORTEE

ALSO PROVIDED TWO WALMART RECEIPTS FOR THE DIGITAL CAMERA RECORDERS.

ON 071819, WRITER AND DEPUTY DAVIS, ID 6096, RESPONDED TO THE REPORTEE'S RESIDENCE IN REFERENCE TO A FOLLOW UP. WRITER MADE CONTACT WITH THE REPORTEE, WHO ADVISED HE STILL DOES NOT WISH TO PRESS CHARGES ON THE SUBJECT FOR ANY OF THE MISSING ITEMS. THE REPORTEE WAS UNABLE TO TELL WRITER THE EXACT TIMES AND DATE THAT THE SUBJECT WAS AT THE LOCATION.
